## **DIPLOMA IN MUSIC PERFORMANCE**

#### Intro

With this diploma, a musician can hone their performance abilities in any area of specialty. A skilled musician must have a wide range of musical styles in order to provide a solid foundation for the development of the abilities required to handle music of many genres and interpretations and to be able to perform for a variety of audiences.

This course gives students the tools they need to exhibit their skills in a variety of settings and for a variety of goals. As good teachers need to have a firm grasp of the repertoire, pedagogical strategies, and interpretive abilities, it is also appropriate for music educators. Students have the choice to use their newly acquired abilities to sit for any external music performance examinations in addition to the qualification they receive after successfully completing the course.

### **Objectives**

Students will receive instruction on how to perform repertoire from various genres. It gradually helps students expand their repertoire and become capable of holding a brief recital with a professional approach in the choice of program targeted at various audiences. The repertory includes significant pieces from the Baroque, Classical, Romantic, and Modern periods. In each performance of each chosen work, this diploma also seeks to increase students' stylistic awareness and performer's showmanship. Through their work on studies, students will also develop and refine their performing techniques.

- Music teachers who need professional training and guidance in music performance

# **Course Duration and Delivery**

### **Examination**

Students will be assessed in the last week of the course. The description of the examination is as below:

In the final exam, students must demonstrate the ability to perform a balanced recital program, offering own-choice repertoire for the examination. Repertoire should be technically demanding in one or more aspect, requiring significant musical understanding and stylistic awareness, and will include at least one large scale structure (e.g. piano sonata) When choosing own-choice works, students should discuss with their respective trainer whether it is on par with the expectations of the standard of performance for this diploma.
